Lessons Learned as President Date: 01/11/2012

Many lessons in life and leadership are learned through personal observation, the help of mentors and our own experience. My friend said he used the following illustration to make the point at hand. He spread a little bit of salt on the table and then gave each class member a single broom straw. Their assigned duty was to collect the salt into a single pile. After a short time it was clear that this method of each doing their thing did not work very well for the task at hand. The leader then collected all the straws and held them in such a way that looked like a miniature whiskbroom. Then each member was given a turn and they all saw that each of them had the ability to be successful, at completing the task at hand, when all worked together for a common cause.

For me, the personal lessons of life have shown that more is learned during those times in the valley than those times on the mountain top. Although the feeling of being on top is exhilarating, it all too soon fades when the time in the valley occurs. However those times in the valley produces life long memories of what works when accomplishing a hard task. I have found that God never asks us to do what He has not already prepared us to do.
