

office this year. I would like to give some helping hints to make the joy of doing membership easier. With the fast response of email it is much easier to answer a question than to fix a challenge later. PLEASE feel free to email me with any concerns you might encounter.

All forms are on the NSDCA website, NSDCA.ORG. So throw the old 3 part forms away and use the new

ones on the web.

Form 1 MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS

In the left column "renewal fee" enter a dollar amount either \$20.00 or \$12.50 and Last name and First name. Please enter an email address ONLY if there is a change. You may type this information at the above email address, print 3 copies and then exit. This information can NOT be saved so you are making 1 of the 3copies for your records. Do not list associate members. Send this in as you collect the dues and do not wait until you have collected from all your members.

Form 2 BADGE ORDER

This is for ordering replacement badges and not for new members. I order badges for new members when I process the New Members Form.

Form III CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Enter the name and then only enter the boxes that have a change.

Form V-C

This form is for officers of your chapter. This is done only when there is a change of officers. Again if there is a change list only the change and mark the other offices with just their name.

NEW MEMBERS FORM

This is the most important one. NSDCA refunds a \$20.00/\$12.50 fee

to the chapter to be used as an offer for a new couple/single to visit and join your chapter. Your chapter will be refunded this amount after the application for membership is received and processed. Those chapters in Canada have a different arrangement. The current membership dues are \$32.00 per couple and \$12.50 for a single membership. This includes the required badges.

Every time you make a change I will send a new membership list to your membership person.
