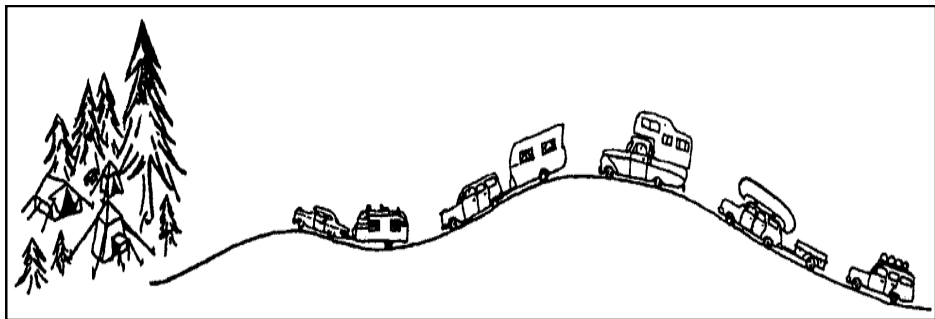

Tell all of your square dancing friends about all the fun we have camping and dancing.

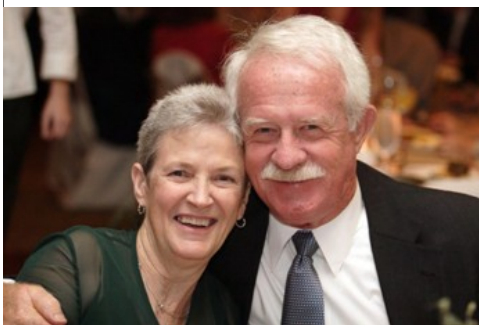
