



WHO MAY BE A NOMINATOR?

NOMINATOR: Any NSDCA member may be a nominator by submitting proposed candidates' name, address, and phone number to a nominating committee member.

WHO SHOULD BE A NOMINEE FOR THE BOARD?

A LEADER: A person who has commanding authority or influence. (Merriam-Webster definition)

IS FAMILIAR: With general operation of NSDCA, have a background of active participation in Chapter affairs, Provincial or State Camporee, or an International Camporee and experience with social, civic, or business organizations.

NOMINEE EXCEPTIONS: Any NSDCA member couple may be nominated except as follows: At no time, may more than one couple, from any one chapter, be on the Board (Bylaws Article IV Section 2b).

NSDCA NOMINATING GUIDELINES

The nominating committee shall:

1. Submit to the President of the Board of Directors, no later than January 5th, no less than two couple nominees, to fill one vacancy on the Board of Directors. These candidates shall meet the following requirements and recommendations:
 - a. The Candidate **MUST BE**:
 - i. Bondable
 - ii. Willing and able to attend:
 1. National Board meetings at NSDCA International Camporee site (at personal expense)
 2. National Board 'winter' meetings if called (at NSDCA expense)
 - iii. Willing and able to serve a 4-year term
 - b. The Candidate **SHOULD**:
 - i. Be familiar with the general operations of NSDCA, Board functions, and officer duties.
 - ii. Have a background of active participation in local Chapter affairs, State or Provincial Camporees, and an International Camporee OR equivalent experience from other social, civic, or business organizations.
 - iii. Have a knowledge of and the capability to use Email and NSDCA.org website to enable NSDCA meetings via the CHAT ROOM on the NSDCA.org Website.
2. Submit with each name a personal profile including a statement of qualification, consent to serve and a photograph of themselves.
